

Full Punta del Este 03 Nights

Day 1 – Montevideo to Punta del Este

Arrive to Carrasco Airport

Transfer by regular bus to Punta del Este (approx. 1.5 hours drive away)

At the bus terminal in Punta del Este, you will board a private transfer with a guide, that'll drive you to the chosen Hotel.

Accommodation is for 3 nights with breakfast included.

Check in at the Hotel and take the rest of the day at your leisure to rest or walk around.

Day 2 – Punta del Este

Pick up from your hotel's lobby to go on the **Punta del Este City Tour and Nonno Antonio visit.**



Start with a scenic drive through Punta's most fashionable and impressive neighborhoods. You will begin your tour in this upscale resort toward the East, sightseeing along the promenade, covering the Brava Beach on the Atlantic Ocean, and passing through several of the area's neighbourhoods, such as San Rafael, Beverly Hills and La Barra de Maldonado, the latter known for its unique hanging bridge. You will then head West along the Mansa Beach, on the River Plate side up to Punta Ballena, where you will be able to see Casapueblo, the unique residence and atelier of the Uruguayan artist Carlos Páez Vilaró (1923-2014). This drive will allow you to enjoy some of Punta's natural wonders like its beaches, woods and rolling landscapes. There will be photo stops at Punta de la Salina, the Hand sculpture of Mario Irarrázabal, La Barra and Punta Ballena, the latter for a panoramic view of the coast. Your drive will continue inland on Camino Lussich, in direction to Nonno Antonio. We will pass the house-museum of Antonio Lussich and the Arboretum he planted in Punta Ballena; he was one of the pioneers of this area. The Arboretum is the largest in the country and one of the most important in South America. It lies on the slope of the La Ballena hills, and contains a unique collection of over 67 species of native and exotic trees. Uruguay is being well known for eco touring and today's tour will provide an opportunity to enjoy that, following your Guide along the footpaths of this green sanctuary.

NONNO ANTONIO. The word "nonno" stands for grandpa in Italian, and the name Nonno Antonio refers to Antonio Ferretti, an Italian from Lombardia, grandfather to Cristiano Ferretti and the founder of the artisan-like cheese making business. The Ferretti family migrated from Italy and Cristiano's passion for cheeses back home drove him to pursue the production dream in Uruguay. Nowadays, the place has changed ownership to Marisa Carvalho, who continues the business with equal passion, and makes every cheese with the love any mother would have for her kids. Every corner of the property is in communion with nature; her special touches and scents can be appreciated throughout.

Day 3 – Punta del Este

Pick up from your hotel's lobby to go on the **Full Day Visit to Agroland.**

You will enjoy a drive through typical Uruguayan countryside, where you will have the chance to spot abundant birdlife along the way, and once close to the ambitious Agroland project site, marvel at the Tuscany-like panoramic view of the surrounding lands of this boutique Olive Oil Producing Plant.

You will see the olive and almond tree plantations on site and tour the plant for an interesting video and live presentation to learn about their select product making.

After being driven into the plantation roads, there'll be a chance to taste their delicious wines and olive oils together with a selection of cheese and home made breads. Lunch will be served as well in these beautiful surroundings. Their on site boutique will be open for anyone wishing to take home any of their great products.



As the bus heads back to Punta del Este, it will take you to the serene, bohemian-style town of Garzón, home to local artists, chefs and others who look for a quieter life style away from the hustle and bustle of the larger cities.



Day 4 – Punta del Este to Montevideo / Depart Uruguay

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and a private transfer will drive you to the Bus Terminal in Punta del Este to take a regular bus to the Montevideo airport.
